SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 158-2024 Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security for the FY22 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant Program; and authorizing the purchase of one or more contracts of smoke/ CO detectors, including installation and installation tools

If approved by Council, Ordinance No. 158-2024 would authorize the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of \$77,619.04 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security for the FY22 Fire Prevention and Safety Grant and includes a cash match of \$3,880.96. This legislation would provide funding for the purchase and installation of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, supplies and informational materials for residents of the City of Cleveland for the Division of Fire.

Purpose of Grant:

This grant will provide funding for the purchase and installation of smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, supplies and informational materials for residents of the City of Cleveland for the Division of Fire.

Budget:

Supplies: \$71,500 (Smoke and smoke/CO detectors, installation tools)
Other: \$10,000 (Printing door hangers, advertising the program)
Total: \$81,500

Grant Term and Amount:

The grant award amount is \$77,619.04 and includes a grant match of \$3,880.96, for a total project amount of \$81,500.

The Grant Period from September 12, 2023 to September 11, 2025.
