AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1436-2019 passed November 18, 2019 as it pertains to authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into agreement with Famicos Foundation for the Needy Family and Senior Food Card Program Distribution Program through the use of Wards 10, 1, 4, 7, 8, 9 and 10 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1436 passed November 18, 2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed ~~\$93,750~~ \$113,750 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1436 passed November 18, 2019 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
