AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the purchase by one or more contracts to demolish blighted and nuisance outdoor payphones and sidewalk restoration services, including storage and disposal of scrap materials, for the Division of Assessment and Licenses, Department of Finance, for a period of two years, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Finance.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is authorized to make one or more written contracts under the Charter and the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, for each or all of the following items: demolition of blighted and nuisance outdoor payphones and sidewalk restoration services, including storage and disposal of scrap materials to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies on a unit basis, for the Division of Assessment and Licenses, Department of Finance, for a period of two years, with two one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Finance may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund Nos. 20 SF 568, 20 SF 574, and 20 SF 579, Request No. RQS 1503, RL 2017-88.

<u>Section 4.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
