**DESCRIPTION:** 

Authorizing the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into agreement with the National Forum of Black Public Administrators to host and sponsor the NFBPA Forum 2018 in Cleveland and authorizing various directors to accept grants and gifts, issue permits, or to enter agreements necessary to host and support the Forum in Cleveland in 2018.

The National Forum for Black Public Administrators (NFBPA) is the professional membership organization dedicated to the advancement of Black leadership in the public sector.

Founded in 1983 in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the membership has grown to include managers and executives in virtually all disciplines represented in state and local governments.

With over 2,500 members representing more the 350 jurisdictions and 40 local chapters in 37 states, NFBPA has emerged as the nation's premier association of Black public leadership.

It has a growing and proud reputation for strengthening the capacity of state and local government managers in a multitude of disciplines, through intensive training, professional development programs.

The organization is governed by a 27 member Board of Directors. The Cleveland Chapter of NFBPA is open to anyone who has an interest in supporting overall mission of the organization.
