Downtown Experiential Lighting

Ordinance No:	520-2023
Legislative Purpose:	Authorizing the Director of City Planning to enter into one or more contracts not to exceed \$1,000,000 for professional services to support the design and programming of several experiential light installations in Downtown Cleveland.
Project Summary:	<p>A striking display of experiential lighting in Downtown Cleveland will create a unique and memorable experience for residents, workers and visitors. Destination Cleveland, in collaboration with partners, will lead a bold experiential lighting project to help make Public Square, Euclid Avenue and the Malls safer, more vibrant and more interesting spaces at night.</p> <p>A variety of lighting placements are proposed in and around public square and the malls, to highlight the unique architecture in the downtown core. Lighting placements will wash public space and surrounding buildings with patterns of colored light. This illumination effort is intended as a first step toward experiential lighting throughout Downtown and into the city's neighborhood commercial districts.</p>
