2025 Progress

Policy, Process, & Government Affairs

- ✓ Secured over \$131M in federal grants for North Coast Connector in 2025
- ✓ Declared and celebrated Carl B. Stokes day
- ✓ Negotiated a 21% pay increase for Cleveland Fire
- ✓ Downtown Cleveland SID renewal
- ✓ Prohibited employers from asking new hires about pay history
- ✓ Expanded safety measures in public parking garages and lots
- ✓ Secured historic and new markets tax incentives for \$50M West Side Market capital investments

Communication

- ✓ TV20's first Emmy
- ✓ Launched The Hub, the City's first Intranet
- ✓ Crisis communications, such as road closures, warming/cooling center operations, and safety updates.
- ✓ Increased social media engagement by establishing a city account on BlueSky
