

Ordinance No. 171-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-177 with Michael Baker International, Inc. to provide pavement management support services project.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 877-2019, passed August 21, 2019, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS 2020-177 with Michael Baker International, Inc. to provide pavement management support services; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 877-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the second option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. PS 2020-177 with Michael Baker International, Inc. to provide pavement management support services. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 877-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
