DEPARTMENT: Parks and Recreation

ORDINANCE NO.: 281-2026

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the Director of Parks and Recreation to enter into a lease agreement with Okra and Honey for a term of up to three years for \$1.00 for each annual lease payment and with a one-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Parks and Recreation.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The leasee shall provide high-quality food and beverage services designed to enhance the overall experience, comfort, and convenience of City Hall staff and the general public within the Cleveland City Hall Cafeteria. Services shall reflect professional standards of excellence, cleanliness, customer service, and operational efficiency.

CONTRACT TERMS: April 1, 2026 – April 30, 2028

- With a one-year option to renew

FUNDING:

- Leasee shall pay the City a lease payment for the provision of this service.
