

Ordinance No. 760-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2019-009 with Johnson Controls, Inc. to provide for labor and materials needed to maintain, repair, and expand fire alarm and suppression systems, including any parts, materials, equipment, supplies, services and installations, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 679-2019, passed July 24, 2019, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. RC 2019-009 with Johnson Controls, Inc. to provide for labor and materials needed to maintain, repair, and expand fire alarm and suppression systems, including any parts, materials, equipment, supplies, services and installations, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 679-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2019-009 with Johnson Controls, Inc. to provide for labor and materials needed to maintain, repair, and expand fire alarm and suppression systems, including any parts, materials, equipment, supplies, services and installations, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control, for the requirements for an additional year. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 679-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
