AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 161-2024, passed June 3, 2024, relating to a grant agreement with Manufacturing Works, or its designee, to provide economic development assistance for the Cleveland Industrial Retention Initiative Program during 2024.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 161-2024, passed June 3, 2024, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the costs of the grant agreement shall not exceed \$500,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. ~~Nos.~~ Nos. 10 SF 501 and 17 SF 652. (RQS 9501, RL 2024-11)

Section 2. That existing Section 2 of Ordinance No. 161-2024, passed June 3, 2024, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
