AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 420-2020, passed May 27, 2020, as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Westown Community Development Corporation for the Westown CDC Code Enforcement Program through the use of Ward 11 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 420-2020, passed May 27, 2020, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed ~~\$70,260~~ \$83,587 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 420-2020 passed May 27, 2020 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
