Executive Summary

The Department of Port Control is requesting authority to exercise the second option to renew Contract No. CT 3001 PS2017*221 with Fire Force, Inc. to provide the Airport Rescue and Firefighting personnel the annual FAA Part 139 ARFF certification training for the Department of Port Control.

Background/Purpose:

The Department of Port Control (“Department”) relies on Fire Force, Inc. to provide the Airport Rescue and Firefighting department with annual FAA Part 139 live fire training.

Scope of Work:

The Airport Rescue and Firefighting (“ARFF”) fire training simulator provided by Fire Force, Inc. provides hands-on training required under FAA Part 139 for annual certification of ARFF personnel as airport firefighters.

Justification/Urgency:

These services are necessary to provide Cleveland Hopkins International Airport Rescue and Firefighting personnel certification as airport rescue firefighting basic firefighters.

These services are outside the scope of the Department’s capability to perform.

Anticipated Cost:

Schedule or Term of Contract:

One year with three one-year options for renewal. The second of the one-year options to renew shall not be exercised without additional legislative authority.
