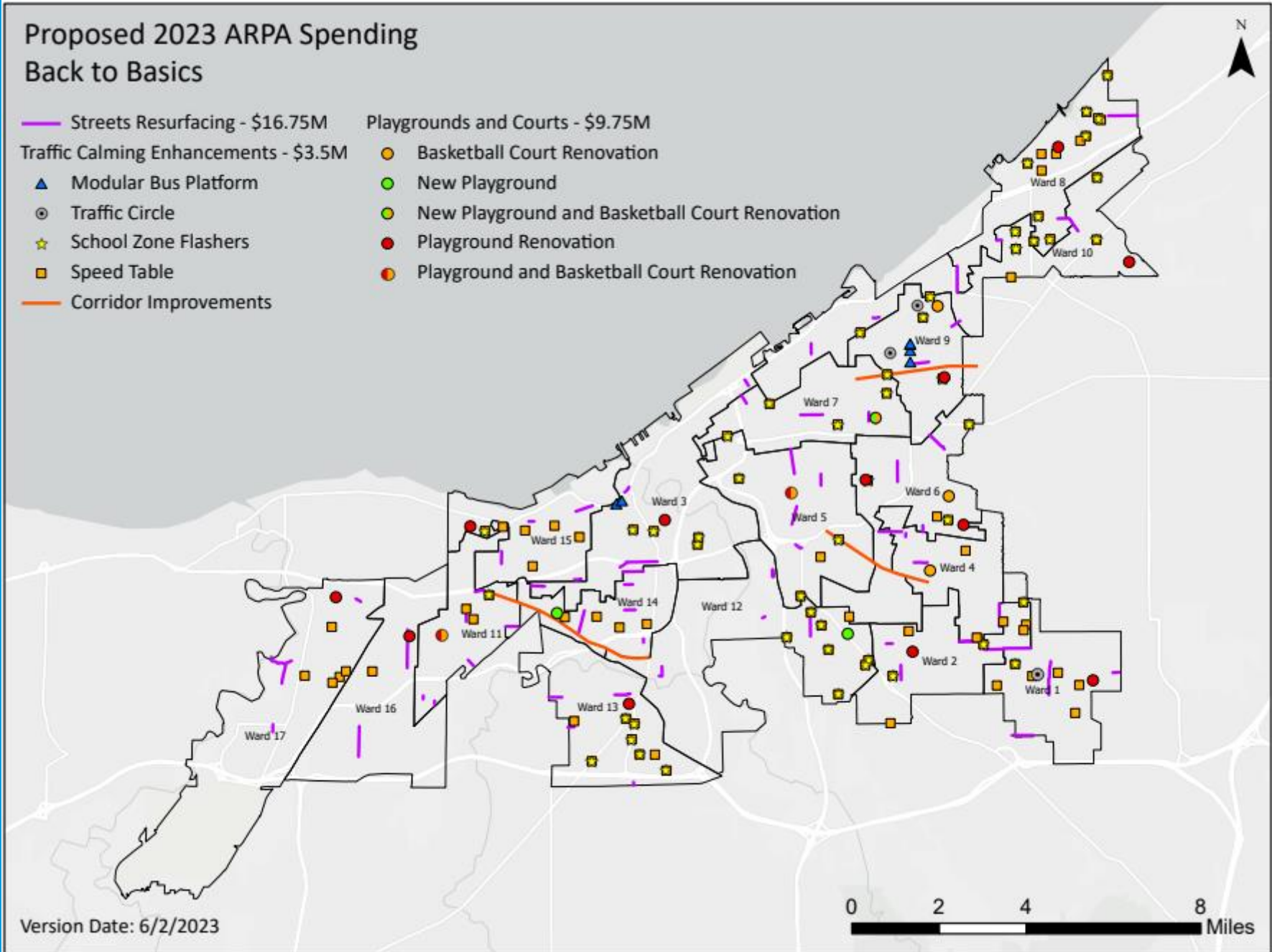

TRAFFIC CALMING

Physical design and other measures installed to reduce vehicle speeds and improve safety

Speed Tables



Formed asphalt speed tables with associated signage, curbside delineators, and roadway striping

Traffic Circles



Traffic circles and/or mini-roundabouts at key residential intersections

Signal Upgrades



Signal detection, ADA push buttons and signage, pedestrian countdown signal heads, retroreflective backplates for Vision Zero corridors.

School Zone Flashers



Automates 20 mph school zone flashers; solar panels at 10 locations

Modular Bus Platforms



Modular rubber bus platforms for safer transit operations and potential for protected bike lanes



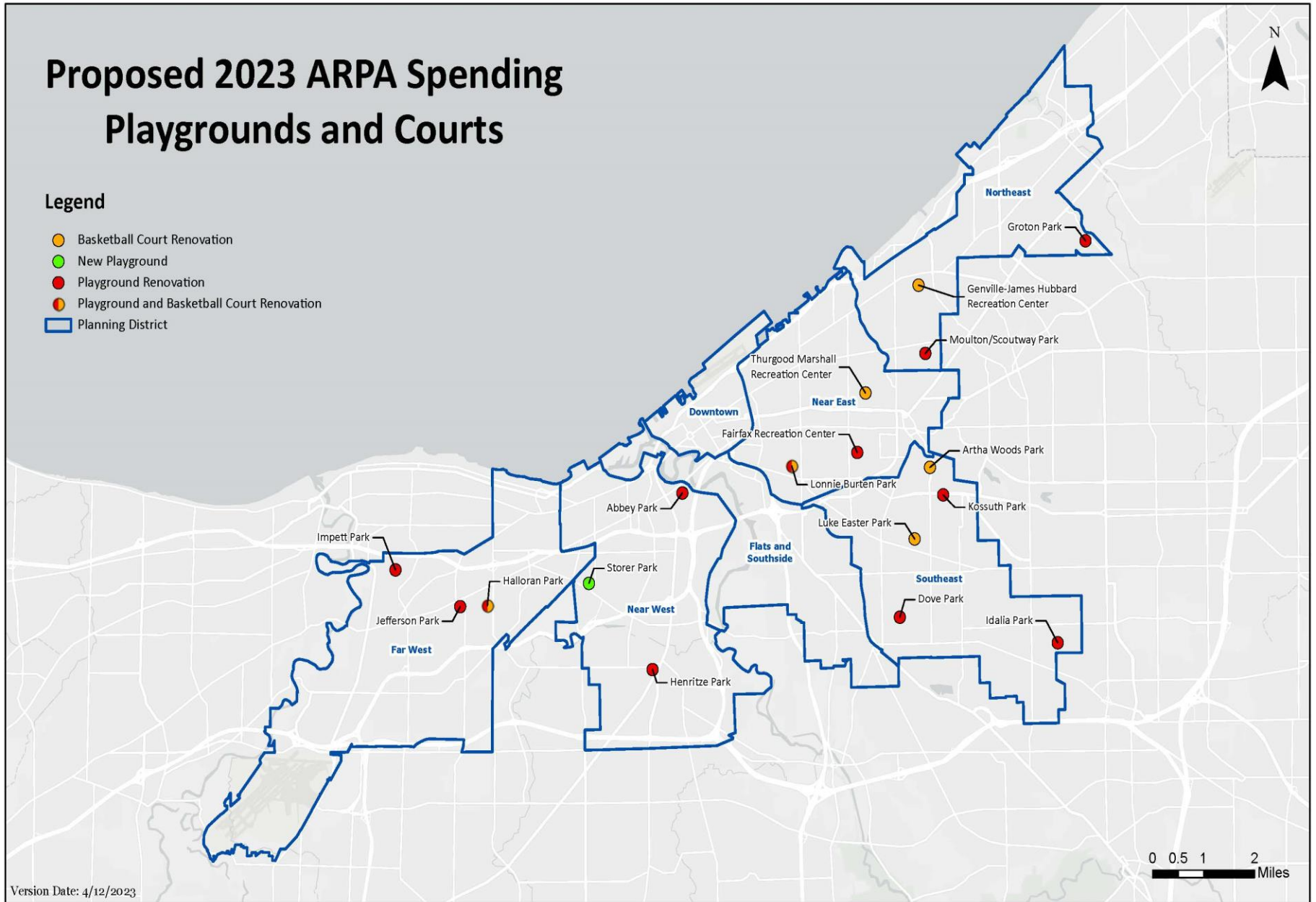

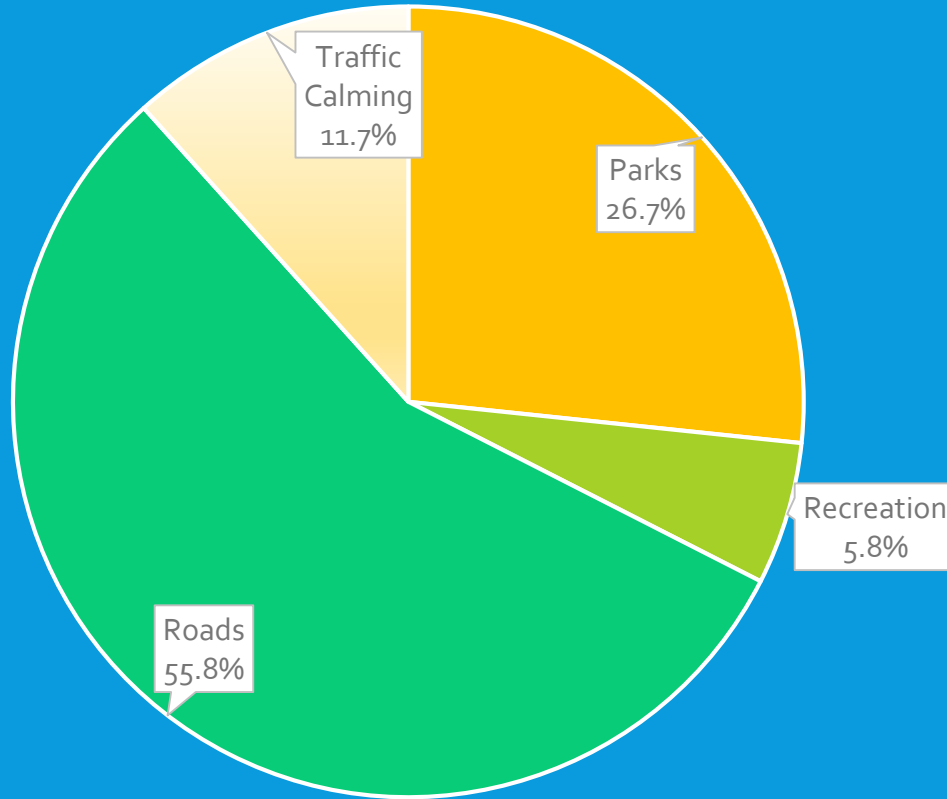
Total ARPA Cost By Category
