# Ordinance No. 1084-2019 (As Amended)

#### **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first options to renew various contracts for the requirements for heavy-duty equipment, snow removal equipment, snow removal vehicles, multi-purpose trucks and operators when required, for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 848-15, passed July 22, 2015, as amended by Ordinance No. 1338-15, passed December 7, 2015, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract Nos. MA 2017-105 with M-B Companies and MA 2017-106 with Wausau Equipment Company Inc.; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 848-15, as amended, requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on these contracts; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract Nos. MA 2017-105 with M-B Companies and MA 2017-106 with Wausau Equipment Company Inc. in the total approximate amount of \$5,000,000 for the requirements for heavy-duty snow removal equipment, heavy-duty equipment, snow removal equipment, snow removal vehicles, multi-purpose trucks and operators when required for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 848-15, as amended, to exercise these options.

**Section 2.** That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
