AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1000-2025, passed August 13, 2025, relating to a forgivable loan with Metro West Community Development Organization, or its designee, to acquire and stabilize mixed commercial buildings throughout the West 14 service area.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1000-2025, passed August 13, 2025, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the costs of the loan shall not exceed two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$2,300,000.00), and shall be paid from Fund No. ~~10 SF 557~~ 10 SF 555, which funds are appropriated for this purpose. (RQS 9501, RL 2025-74)

Section 2. That existing Section 3 of Ordinance No. 1000-2025, passed August 13, 2025, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
