AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, District Council 6, AFL-CIO, Local 639; and to amend Section 13 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to salaries for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, District Council 6, AFL-CIO, Local 639, under the terms contained in **File No. 1139-2023-A**, for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

| <u>Increase</u> | <u>Approximate Date of Increase</u> |
|-----------------|-------------------------------------|
| 2% | April 1, 2022 |
| 3% | April 1, 2023 |
| 2% | April 1, 2024 |

Section 2. That Section 13 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

Section 13. International Union of Painters and Allied Trades, District Council 6, AFL-CIO, Local 639. That salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

| | Classification | Minimum | Maximum | Amended Maximum |
|---|-------------------------------------|----------------|------------------|------------------------|
| 1 | Sign Painter | 37.10 | 37.84 | 40.75 |
| 2 | Sign Painter Unit Leader | 39.94 | 40.74 | 43.87 |
| 3 | Traffic Sign and Marking Supervisor | 29.07 | 29.66 | 31.94 |
| 4 | Traffic Sign Process Operator | 29.12 | 29.70 | 31.98 |

Section 3. That existing Section 13 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
