Project Summary	On August 6, 2024, the Ohio Department of Development (“ODOD”) awarded the City a \$7,628,055 Brownfields Remediation Program Grant to conduct demolition, asbestos and waste removal, and site remediation at the former National Acme site (see attached map). The City will provide 25% matching funds totaling \$2,542,685, as required by this grant. Matching funds will be drawn from the Department of Building and Housing’s National Acme demolition fund 21-020, which has sufficient unencumbered funds to meet the match requirement.
