

Ordinance No. 662-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Directors of Public Works and Public Safety to enter into one or more contracts with the American National Red Cross for an emergency shelter relief plan using the City's Neighborhood Resource and Recreation Centers and other suitable City facilities, for a period not to exceed two years.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Directors of Public Works and Public Safety are authorized to enter into one or more contracts with the American National Red Cross ("Red Cross") to allow the Red Cross to use the City's Neighborhood Resource and Recreation Centers and other suitable City facilities for emergency shelter relief during a disaster, for periods not to exceed thirty (30) days. The term of the contract shall not exceed two years.

Section 2. The contract or contracts shall be prepared by the Director of Law and shall contain such terms and conditions that protect the City's interest, including but not limited to, that the Red Cross will reimburse the City for damages, costs associated with custodial and food service personnel and out-of-pocket operations costs such as water, gas, electricity, and waste disposal.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
