Section 1. That Ordinance No. 2085-05, passed February 13, 2006, and Ordinance No. 1503-08, passed October 6, 2008, are repealed.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
