2026 Non-Compliant Sidewalk Repairs Program (Formally Known as the 50/50 Program)

Ordinance No.: 1471-2025

Purpose: Legislation to authorize a public improvement by requirements

contract to repair specific non compliant sidewalk from any and all funds as authorized by the Director of Finance, and to authorize the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects to apply, accept and expend grants and gifts. This work will be conducted under the City's Non-Compliant Sidewalk Repairs Program, formally known as the 50/50 Sidewalk Program, which promotes resident participation by offering a cost-sharing model

where the City covers half the repair costs. The legislation would also authorize the Director of the Mayor's Office of

Capital Projects to apply for, accept, and expend grants and gifts

in support of the program.

The bid documents will be set up to promote the use of small businesses by limiting quantities to produce bids in the range of

\$50,000 to \$300,000.

Description: This public improvement will be carried out through a

requirements contract to repair sidewalks, with residents or a third party contributing their portion of the City-provided cost estimate. Repairs will be based on unit prices established in the

executed contract.
