WHEREAS, Section 115-5 of the Charter of the City of Cleveland, effective November 2, 2021, requires that the Mayor appoint members to the Community Police Commission, with approval of the Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 115-5, the Mayor and the Council, along with community members, reviewed and made recommendations from interested applicants; and

WHEREAS, this nomination was reviewed by the Council’s Committees on Safety and on Mayor’s Appointments; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council hereby approves the appointment of Tera Coleman to the Community Police Commission to the term ending December 5, 2028.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
