Request for Legislation

An Ordinance to authorize the Director of the Department of Public Utilities to enter into one or more requirement contracts for the purchase of Labor and Materials to Inspect, Test at High Voltage Levels and Repair Bucket and Derrick Trucks, for the Division of Cleveland Public Power for a period of two (2) years.

Background/Purpose:

Labor and materials needed for the inspection, testing and maintenance of hydraulic aerial bucket trucks, and derrick digger trucks.

Scope of Work/Commodities/Services:

Labor, materials, and equipment necessary for the inspection and testing at high voltage levels and the maintenance of hydraulic aerial bucket trucks and digger trucks as required per ANSI A-92.2. for the Division of Cleveland Public Power.

Justification/Urgency:

This contract will set into place the process to expedite the testing and repair of hydraulic aerial devices for vehicle mounted elevating and rotating platforms per OSHA standards and ANSI specifications as outlined in ANSI A-92.2 1990.

Anticipated Costs and funding source:

The projected estimate for the two (2) year contract is \$500,000.00. General Operating Budget.
