

Cleveland City Council Executive Summary Finance Committee Monday, February 10, 2020

Ordinance 115-2020

The Department of Human Resources is seeking approval to ratify the 2019-2022 Collective Bargaining Agreement for the Cleveland Fingerprint/Scientific Examiners, FOP/OLCI and amend Section 28 of the City-wide Payband Ordinance.

1. <u>ARTICLE 35 - COMPENSATION</u> WAGES:

First year:

2% wage increase

Second year:

2% wage increase

Third year:

2% wage increase

Effective April 1, 2020, a Fingerprint Examiner receiving their certification shall receive compensation at a rate of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) above their applicable step.

<u>Section 28.</u> Cleveland Scientific Examiners – Fingerprinters (FOP/OLCI) That the salaries and the compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:
