

Ordinance No. 243-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Human Resources, or other appropriate director, to apply for and accept one or more grants from the Cleveland Foundation to place approximately ten Public Service Fellows in various departments for a period of one year.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Human Resources, or other appropriate director, is authorized to apply for and accept one or more grants in an aggregate amount of approximately \$500,000, from the Cleveland Foundation to place approximately ten Public Service Fellows in various departments for a period of one year. That the Director(s) is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant or grants; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in this ordinance.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
