AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Amending Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 745-2019 passed June 3, 2019 as it pertains to authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Safety to enter into an agreement with Bellaire-Puritas Development Corporation for the Summer Safety Education Film Series through the use of Ward 16 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 745-2019 passed June 3, 2019 are hereby amended to read as follow:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Public Safety into agreement effective ~~May 23, 2018~~ May 1, 2019 with the Bellaire-Puritas Development Corporation for the Summer Safety Education Film Series for the public purpose of providing safety education programming on drug use, violence and crime prevention to city of Cleveland residents through the use of Ward 16 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed ~~\$30,000~~ \$15,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 2. That Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 745-2019 passed June 3, 2019 are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
