

Ordinance No. 1455-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the purchase by one or more contracts of labor and materials necessary to retrofit a Division of Police command bus, including installation, for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works and/or the Department of Public Safety.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Directors of Public Works and/or Public Safety are authorized to make one or more written contracts under the Charter and the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, for each or all of the following items: labor and materials necessary to retrofit a Division of Police command bus, including installation, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies on a unit basis, for the Division of Motor Vehicle Maintenance, Department of Public Works and the Department of Public Safety.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases and/or services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Directors of Public Works and/or Public Safety may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases and/or obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors and/or consultants selected through that cooperative process. The Directors of Public Works and/or Public Safety shall provide written notice to the Clerk of Council whenever any purchase is made through the cooperative process, which notice shall include the details of such cooperative purchase.

Section 3. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized in the estimated amount of \$320,000 shall be paid from Fund Nos. 10 SF 400, 11 SF 006, and 15 SF 190. (RQS 7015, RL 2025-90)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
