

Ordinance No. 747-2026

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE
To change the name of a portion of Scranton
Road to Eagle Avenue.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the
usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding and as an exception to the Codified
Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, the name of a portion of Scranton Road shall be
changed to Eagle Avenue, limits further described as follows:

Being all that portion of Scranton Road, extending easterly from the easterly line of
West 3rd Street to the westerly line of Ontario Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and,
provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period
allowed by law.
