

Ordinance No. 481-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into one or more maintenance and repair agreements to reimburse up to five signatory airlines for costs needed to provide repairs, preventative maintenance and renovation services for leased City-owned passenger boarding bridges, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the Master Lease and Agreement authorized by Ordinance No. 1162-2016, passed October 24, 2016, the City agreed, among other things, to repair, maintain, and upkeep City-owned passenger boarding jet bridges with five signatory airlines; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into one or more maintenance and repair agreements to reimburse up to five signatory airlines the amount necessary to provide repairs, preventative maintenance and renovation services for leased City-owned passenger boarding bridges, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control.

Section 2. That the agreements shall be prepared by the Director of Law and shall contain any terms and conditions that the Director deems necessary to protect and benefit the public interest.

Section 3. That the aggregate cost of this ordinance shall not exceed \$1,000,000, but each of the five maintenance and repair agreements shall not exceed \$200,000 each, and shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001 and 60 SF 141. (RQS 3001, RL 2023-37)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
