AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Safety to enter into agreement with the Ginger Ridge MHA or its designee for the public purpose of providing the E. 105 Safety and Security Program through the use of Ward 9 Neighborhood Equity Funds.

WHEREAS, providing a community safety program to reduce risks, prevent harm, and promote the well-being of all residents through collaborative, prevention focused, and inclusive efforts is a calid public purpose for municipal expenditures providing for he education, health, wellness, and general welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Public Safety is authorized to enter into a contract with Ginger Ridge MHA or its designee for the E. 105th Safety and Security Program for the public purpose of providing a crime reduction and community engagement program through the use of Ward 9 Neighborhood Equity Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 166.

Section 3. Project shall begin as of June 1, 2026.

Section 4. That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City’s interest.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
