OVERVIEW

The City has been awarded a USDOT Regional Infrastructure Accelerators (RIA) grant to provide targeted services and support for the Shore-to-Core-to-Shore initiative and other projects eligible for federal credit programs managed by the US Department of Transportation's Build America Bureau that provide low-interest loans and financial support for major infrastructure and transit-oriented development. This grant will allow the City to identify potential projects eligible for additional funding under the TIFIA and RRIF programs as well as support the ongoing project of creating an accessible lakefront and riverfront.

The Directors of Development and Finance will employ by contract or contracts one or more consultants to provide professional services necessary to implement the goals laid out in the City's Regional Infrastructure Accelerator grant application, including, but not limited to, financial advisory, planning, market analysis, project-development, public-private partnership development, program-management, and related services.
