

# Resolution No. 1097-2025

## AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

Requesting the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima-facie speed limit of 30 miles per hour for Lake Avenue between West 117<sup>th</sup> Street and Detroit Avenue.

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland conducted a Speed Zone Study on Lake Avenue following guidance from the Ohio Department of Transportation's Traffic Engineering Manual; and

WHEREAS, the Speed Zone Study results recommended 30 miles per hour as a safe and reasonable speed limit on Lake Avenue between West 117<sup>th</sup> Street and Detroit Avenue; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council requests the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio determine and declare a reasonable and safe prima-facie speed limit of 30 miles per hour for Lake Avenue between West 117<sup>th</sup> Street and Detroit Avenue.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is directed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Director of Transportation of the State of Ohio.

Section 3. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
