AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association (OPBA) (Protective Services Unit); and to amend Section 14 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association (OPBA) (Protective Services Unit), under the terms contained in File No. 836-2025-A, for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

Increase	Approximate Date of Increase
2%	April 1, 2022
2%	April 1, 2023
2%	April 1, 2024

Section 2. That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 569-2021, passed July 14, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Section 14. Ohio Patrolmen’s Benevolent Association (OPBA) (Protective Services Officer Unit). That salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

	Minimum	Maximum

Section 3. That existing Section 14 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 569-2021, passed July 14, 2021, is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
