NORTHEAST OHIO MUNI FOOTBALL LEAGUE**

DIVISION: Recreation

ORDINANCE NO: 172-2021

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Works to enter into a contract with Northeast Ohio Muni Football League, aka Cleveland Municipal Football Association dba Cleveland Muni Football League to conduct a citywide youth football program and to pay various entry fees.

CONTRACT TERMS: One year contract: May 1, 2021 – December 31, 2021

ESTIMATED AMOUNT: \$80,084 - The Northeast Ohio Muni Football League uses this amount to supplement costs as follows:

- \$13,801.00 - Insurance
- \$29,520.00 - Field Staff (regular season)
- \$6,592.00 - Field Staff (play-off season)
- \$15,912.00 - Security (regular/play-off season)
- \$3,654.00 - Referee Fees (for Cleve. Rec. teams)
- \$2,305.00 - Office Support Staff and Supplies
- \$2,800 - Cheerleading Activities
- \$5,500 - Awards

PREVIOUS CONTRACT: Contract No. CT-7004-PS-2020-95 - \$80,084

PROGRAM BACKGROUND: Northeast Ohio Muni Football League has been in existence for over 90 years. More than 93,000 youth from the ages of 6-14 have participated in the program.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

There were a total of 16 organizations in 2020 totaling 47 football teams and 23 cheerleader squads. The team age divisions are as follows:
