### Ord. No. 1380-2025

By Council Members Griffin and Polensek

An emergency ordinance to amend Section 621.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as enacted by Ordinance No. 54-74, passed March 25, 1974, relating to menacing of a healthcare worker.

Remarks by Director of Safety: See Legislation.

Remarks by Director of Law Department: There is no legal objection to the passage of this legislation if amended.

### Ord. No. 232-2026

By Council Members Bishop, Polensek, Santana and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance determining the method of making the public improvement of designing, constructing, rehabilitating, renovating, replacing or otherwise improving public facilities, buildings, and other similar structures, including site improvements and appurtenances; and authorizing the Director of Public Safety, Public Works, Parks and Recreation and/or Capital Projects, as appropriate, to enter into one or more public improvement contracts for the making of the improvements; enter into one or more professional services and other contracts needed to implement the improvements; to apply for and accept grants and gifts; and authorizing the direct employment of the necessary labor, for the Department of Public Safety, Public Works, Parks and Recreation and/or the Office of Capital Projects.

Remarks by Director of Capital Projects: See Legislation.

Remarks by Director of Law Department: There is no legal objection to the passage of this legislation if amended.

### Ord. No. 359-2026

By Council Members Polensek and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Mayor and/or the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security, FEMA, for the FY25 Port Security Grant Program; and authorizing the purchase by one or more requirement contracts for safety equipment for use on the fire boat, supplies, and operation search and rescue training needed, for the Division of Fire, Department of Public Safety.

Estimated Cost: \$60,596
