Ordinance No. 824-2020

Purpose: This Department requests legislation to grant consent to

ODOT to construct Pedestrian Safety Improvements at various, PID 11330, in the City of Cleveland and to

authorize the Director of Capital Projects to enter into one

or more agreements with ODOT to make the

improvement.

Description: ODOT will arrange for the preparation of construction

plans and specifications, including engineering reports,

and for the supervision and administration of the

construction cost and contribute 100% of the eligible costs. The pedestrian safety improvement project within the City of Cleveland includes enhancements to pavement markings, signage, roadway features and signalization. The roadway features consist of ADA curb ramps, curb extensions, refuge islands and reducing curb radii. The signalization consists of pedestrian Hybrid Beacons, new pedestrian countdown signals and upgrade to pedestrian countdown signals. These enhancements are part of ODOT's initiative to improve pedestrian safety on or adjacent to Highways within the State. There are 61

locations within the City of Cleveland being improved.
