

Ordinance No. 226-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed December 9, 2020, relating to the East 66th Street Roadway Improvement Project.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed December 9, 2020, are amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the Director of Capital Projects is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Osborn Engineering for professional services necessary to design the Improvement from Euclid Avenue to Superior Avenue, or to other East 66th Street intersections within the aforementioned limits, for the Office of Capital Projects. The compensation to be paid for the preliminary design services shall not exceed ~~\$250,000~~ \$431,332 unless additional grant funds or other funds as authorized by the Director of Finance are made available, and the compensation to be paid for other professional design services shall be fixed by the Board of Control.

Section 10. That the cost of the contracts, property acquisition, or other expenditure shall be paid from Fund Nos. 20 SF 568, 20 SF 574, 20 SF 579, 20 SF 586, 20 SF 592, 20 SF 597, from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant funds or gifts accepted under this ordinance, and any other funds approved by the Director of Finance. Section 2. That existing Sections 2 and 10 of Ordinance No. 822-2020, passed December 9, 2020, are repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
