DIVISION: Street Maintenance

ORDINANCE NO: 467-2026

DESCRIPTION: Legislation authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more Requirement Contracts, for general maintenance and lubrication requirements of all mechanical fittings, cables, structural repair, Millwright services machinery and appurtenances, for six (6) active mechanical or movable bridges, including all lubricants, for the Division of Streets for one (1) year with two (2) additional one-year renewal options at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: Passage of this legislation is necessary to contract for labor, equipment and incidental materials needed for maintenance, lubrication and structural repairs to six (6) moveable bridges within the City limits according to the revised schedules and American Association of Highway and Transportation Officials (AASHTO) compliant charts and to support the Division of Streets mechanical bridges.

Carter Road Lift Bridge - 1700 Carter Road
Center Street Swing Bridge – 1200 Center Street
Columbus Road Lift Bridge – 1905 Columbus Road
West 3rd Street Lift Bridge – 2150 West Third Street
Willow Avenue Lift Bridge – 1210 River Road
North Coast Harbor Bridge - 1012 East 9th Street

CURRENT CONTRACT: The Great Lakes Construction Co.

\$375,000.00 per year

NEW CONTRACT TERM: One (1) year with two (2) additional one-year renewal options at the discretion of the Director of Public Works.

ESTIMATED CONTRACT AMOUNT: 400,000.00/per year

FUNDING SOURCE: Operating Budget, Restricted Income Tax, NEF Funds, and additional funding sources as deemed appropriate by the Director of Finance.
