

THERE IS NO LEGAL OBJECTION TO THIS LEGISLATION IF AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

1. In the title, line 1, insert "EMERGENCY" between "An" and "Ordinance".
2. Insert the new whereas clause to read as follows:

"WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health or safety in that it limits the amount of window coverings to increase visibility for first responders to assess an emergency and for other individuals to see potential hazards, such as oncoming vehicles; now, therefore,".

3. Strike Section 4 in its entirety and insert:

"Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law."
