

Resolution No. 831-2020

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION
Declaring the intent to vacate a portion of Muriel Court S.W.

By Council Members Kelley, Johnson and Brancatelli (by departmental request)

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate a portion of Muriel Court S.W. (10 feet wide), as described; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the following described real property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and being a portion of Muriel Court S.W. (10 feet wide) in the Brooklyn Park Allotment of part of Original Brooklyn Township Lot No. 57 as shown by the recorded plat in Volume 21 of Maps, Page 15 of Cuyahoga County Records further described as follows:

Being all that portion of Muriel Court S.W. (10 feet wide) extending Westerly from the northerly prolongation of the Easterly line of Sub Lot 94 in said Brooklyn Park Allotment, approximately 40.00 feet to that portion of Muriel Court S.W. (10 feet wide) vacated by City of Cleveland Ordinance 152-78, passed February 27, 1978.

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section.

Section 2. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
