

Ordinance No. 633-2024 AS AMENDED

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a license agreement with a vendor to install and maintain an automated teller machine terminal located in Room 122, Vital Statistics for the use and convenience of the general public, for a period of one year, with a one-year option to renew, ~~exercisable by the Director of Public Works.~~ exercisable by additional legislative authority.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 183.16 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into a license agreement with a vendor, based on competitive proposals, granting the right to use and occupy City-owned property located within Cleveland City Hall for the installation and maintenance of an automated teller machine terminal located in Room 122, Vital Statistics for the use and convenience of the general public. The selection of the vendor and consideration for the license shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of Public Works. The license agreement shall include the requirement that the vendor selected is in compliance with City CRA requirements.

Section 2. That the term of the license agreement shall be for a period of one year, with a one-year option to renew, ~~exercisable by the Director of Public Works.~~ exercisable by additional legislative authority.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
