Executive Summary Solid Waste Disposal Program

Background/Purpose:

- ♦ This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into a contract with the Cuyahoga County Solid Waste District for the Solid Waste Disposal Program.
- Review and process all applications for permits to operate Construction and Demolition Landfills in the City of Cleveland.
- Inspections of scrap tire transporters, storage facilities and respond to all scrap tire illegal dumping complaints.
- Conduct quarterly inspections of State mandated facilities, issue violation notices to enforce State and Local regulations.
- Record and maintain records of all Solid Waste Facilities in the City of Cleveland, which include; Solid Waste Transfer Facilities, Composting Facilities, Construction and Demolition Debris Sites, Methane Gas Monitoring, and Industrial Waste Landfills.
- Assure quality of data as required by Federal Law and State guidelines.

This ordinance would continue to allow the Solid Waste Program to:

- Ensure the proper disposal of solid and infectious waste within the City of Cleveland.
- To safeguard the residents of the City of Cleveland from the migration of methane gas, by performing routine test on open and closed landfills.
- Routine inspections conducted of Solid and Infectious Waste facilities to ensure the facilities are operating within the City of Cleveland's Codified Ordinance and the State of Ohio Solid Waste Regulations.
