

Ordinance No. 176-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an amendment to Contract No. MA1505-RC 2022-32 with Lorain County Landfill, LLC, to add additional services for the handling and disposal of solid waste loads.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 477-2021, passed July 14, 2021, the Director of Public Works entered into Contract No. MA1505-RC 2022-32 with Lorain County Landfill, LLC, for the transfer and disposal of solid waste for the Division of Waste Collection and Disposal in the Department of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operations of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. MA1505-RC 2022-32 with Lorain County Landfill, LLC, to authorize the handling and disposal of municipal solid waste loads that have a radioactive signature at an additional cost of \$1,300.00 per load, as needed. All other terms and conditions of this contract shall remain the same.

Section 2. That the amendment to the above-referenced contract shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
