AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into one or more contracts with Convergent Technologies LLC for the equipment, installation, maintenance, and annual software subscriptions for the Evolv Express and Evolv eXpedite weapons screening systems at the new Police Headquarters, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of four years.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Convergent Technologies LLC for the equipment, installation, maintenance, and annual software subscriptions for the Evolv Express and Evolv eXpedite weapons screening systems at the new Police Headquarters, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety, for a period of four years.

Section 2. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases and/or services authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Public Safety may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases and/or obtain such services, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors and/or consultants selected through that cooperative process.

Section 3. That the cost of the contract or contracts for year one of the four-year contract shall not exceed \$142,813.92, and the cost of the contracts for years two through four shall not exceed \$104,521.36 per year, and subject to annual appropriation, for a total contract amount of \$456,378.00. The contract or contracts shall be payable from Fund No. 01-6002-6612. (RQS 6002, RLA 2026-81)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
