

Ordinance No. 998-17

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To add the name “Rev. Dr. A. Charles Bowie Way” as a secondary and honorary name to East 100th Street between Euclid Avenue and Carnegie Avenue.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding and as an exception to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cleveland, 1976, the name “Rev. Dr. A. Charles Bowie Way” shall be added as a secondary and honorary name to East 100th Street between Euclid Avenue and Carnegie Avenue.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
