AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation to purchase materials and equipment for the Cleveland Foundry Rowing Program providing rowing and safety equipment and lessons for Cleveland youth at city neighborhood recreation and resource centers through the use of Ward 3 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, providing free participation at City recreation centers engaging youth in health and exercise related activities and providing exposure to rowing and swim safety activities uncommon in inner-city neighborhoods, the critical importance of this sports program is a valid public purpose for municipal expenditures providing for the education, health, wellness, and general welfare of the public; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation is hereby authorized to enter into agreement to purchase rowing program equipment providing health and wellness activities for Cleveland youth through the use of Ward 3 Casino Revenue.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$15,590.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. SF 166 using the fund and project number from the following Ward.

<u>Ward</u>	<u>Amount</u>	<u>Project Number</u>

Section 3. Project shall begin as of May 11, 2026

Section 4. That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
