AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION

In support of the application submitted by Western Reserve Land Conservancy to the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Fund Program for the purchase of the Euclid Beach Expansion Project.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Public Works Commission, administers financial assistance for conservation purposes through the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Program (“Clean Ohio”); and

WHEREAS, Western Reserve Land Conservancy desires financial assistance for the acquisition of the 28.5 acre parcel (PPN 113-01-001) that will comprise the Euclid Beach Expansion Project area in the City of Cleveland, Cuyahoga County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cleveland recognizes the importance of lakefront access and quality green space to provide opportunities to gather, recreate, reflect and enjoy nature, improving quality of life for residents; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council supports the application submitted by Western Reserve Land Conservancy to the Clean Ohio Green Space Conservation Fund Program for the purchase of the Euclid Beach Expansion Project.

Section 2. That the Clerk of Council is directed to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to Western Reserve Land Conservancy.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
