## **Ordinance No. 323-2025**

### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 143.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 413-2024, passed May 13, 2024, relating to applications for and acceptance of fellowship, and intern grants and other funding and services from any public or private entity to add apprenticeship grants.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

That Section 143.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, Section 1. 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 413-2024, passed May 13, 2024, is amended to read as follows:

Applications for and Acceptance of Fellowship, Section 143.06 Apprenticeship and Intern Grants and Other Funding and Services from Any Public or **Private Entity** 

- The Director of Human Resources, or other appropriate Director, is (a) authorized to apply for and accept grants and other funding and services from any public or private entity for programs to provide funding for current employees or to place fellows, apprentices, and interns in various City departments under a City apprenticeship or intern program established for purposes of recruitment. The appropriate Director is authorized to file all papers, execute all documents, and enter into any agreements necessary to apply for, accept, and/or receive the funds or services. Any funds received shall be appropriated for the purposes described in this section. The appropriate Director will notify the Council in writing where and when the fellows and interns are placed.
- The appropriate Director is further authorized to pay cash matching funds up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) if required to receive grant funding. The matching funding shall be paid from funds appropriated for the use of the applicable City department. Any grant that requires a cash match over fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall require additional legislative authority.

That existing Section 143.06 of the Codified Ordinances of Section 2. Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 413-2024, passed May 13, 2024, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
