

Ordinance No. 238-2025

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 402-2022, passed June 6, 2022, relating to general planning, engineering and design services to add an additional funding source.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 2 Ordinance No. 402-2022, passed June 6, 2022, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2. That the cost of contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. ~~Nos.~~ Nos. 60 SF 001 and 60 SF 126, RQS 3001, RL 2022-44.

Section 2. That Section 2 Ordinance No. 402-2022, passed June 6, 2022, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
