

Ordinance No. 215-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into a license agreement with Key Bank National Association to use and occupy City-owned property located within Cleveland City Hall for the installation and maintenance of a Key Bank automated teller machine terminal located in Room 122, Vital Statistics for the use and convenience of the general public, for a period of two years with one additional one-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

WHEREAS, Key Bank National Association (“Key Bank”) and the City of Cleveland desire to continue the use of a Key Bank automated teller machine terminal located in Room 122, Vital Statistics for the use and convenience of the general public; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That, notwithstanding Section 183.16 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into a license agreement with Key Bank whereby the City grants Key Bank the right to use and occupy City-owned property located within Cleveland City Hall for the installation and maintenance of a Key Bank automated teller machine terminal located in Room 122, Vital Statistics for the use and convenience of the general public, at a cost of \$1.00 and other valuable consideration.

Section 2. That the term of the license agreement shall be for two years with one additional one-year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.

Section 3. That the license agreement shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 4. That the Director of Public Works and the Director of Law, and other appropriate City officials, are authorized to execute such other documents and certificates, and take such other action as may be necessary or appropriate to effect the license agreement or agreements authorized by this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
