Withdrawing objection to the transfer of location of a C1 and C2 Liquor Permit at 8302 Carnegie Avenue and repealing Resolution No. 24-2026, objecting to said permit.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to the transfer of ownership of a C1 and C2 Liquor Permit to Sadeen Gas, Inc., 8302 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103, Permanent No. 10009174-1 by Resolution No. 24-2026 adopted by the Council on January 12, 2026; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the transfer of ownership of a C1 and C2 Liquor Permit to Sadeen Gas, Inc., 8302 Carnegie Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio 44103, Permanent No. 10009174-1, be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 24-2026, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
